## Special Religious Education Enrolment - Year 7

Special Religious Education (SRE) will be made available to all Year 7 students in 2020 at Bellingen High School. The subject is being delivered by the Waterfall Way Christian Education Committee (WWCEC) and being implemented in accordance with the NSW Department of Education Special Religious Education and General Religious Education Policy.

Parents/Carers in public schools have the right to have their child receive instructions in their religious persuasion, where authorised teachers of that persuasion are available and parents have the right to choose not to have their child attend SRE. A parent/carer who chooses for their child **to participate** can return the attached consent slip, contact the school's Front Office or send a note in with their child at any time during the year. Children not doing SRE will be supervised by a teacher in a separate space and will be provided with meaningful activities such as reading, private study or completing homework. Those students who participate in SRE will be offered one period every week.

Paul McGovern, President of Waterfall Way Christian Education Committee writing on behalf of the Committee said "SRE scripture is a dynamic part of a student's educational experience. When done well, it brings students in contact with a values-based exploration of life that will help to shape them in a more responsible and assured worldview. Such a program can help them in their studies, in their life generally and in the school community. We have also witnessed situations where closer contact with the church community has provided a wonderful avenue for the school to draw on outside resources and strength in times of tragedy. Waterfall Way Christian Education Committee is looking forward to developing a positive and fruitful relationship with your school community."
