3.1 Principal's Report

- 1.8 positions are unfilled. Extra teacher in English. Trying to permanently appoint Peter Fox current head science teacher. Still needing an Aboriginal studies teacher.
- 2 unfilled vacancies in Learning Support 2x Mulitcategorial Class (MC) mental health and AU.

- Planning for 7 classes of MU in the future. Funding being spent (part of the Strategic Improvement Plan) is for teaching teachers how to identify and to deescalate conflicts before it becomes a bigger or more dangerous issue.
- Learning plans should be evaluated each year together with parents.
- If a child is not in a Supported Learning Class the school can apply for funding to assist with having an SLSO.
- Received Anticipated Budget for 2024 which is down from 2023. Staffing money has gone up to pay for additional teachers, however the Operational Budget has gone down. This will impact expenditure for classes such as TAS which is a resource heavy faculty and CAPA arts. It will mean less to spend on supplies.
- The new Principal position closes this Wednesday. It should take approx. 2 weeks for a decision.

5. OTHER BUSINESS (Chair)

- A parent has recently received a phone call SC Muskett (Bellingen Police) in regards to the incident in August where BHS student broke into St Mary's. Only made contact two weeks ago. Inaccurately identified a student who couldn't have been there. Parent is upset at the allegation and assumption made by the police rather than investigating further. Concerned that students who are involved in this incident are putting names forward of others who are not involved.
- What is the expectation for uncovered classes? Classes are sent to the Library where it is expecting that students will do own study. School is looking into Meadow Bank where year 12 teachers who are finished year 12 classes for the year can assist, however currently they can only pick up classes if there is teacher sickness (not shortage due to other absences). There is still a shortfall of teachers.
